Why Non-Fiction?


We are often asked why we chose to start a non-fiction publishing company. To answer that question, we actually need to go back quite a few decades....





Earth's insects are in trouble. That's one half of this book's simple but incredibly important message. The book's other, more hopeful, "call to action" is that everyone can do something to help protect bees, beetles and thousands of other insects.

Without insects, many animals, including birds, amphibians, fish and reptiles could not survive.
